"WHAT'S AHEAD FOR THE ISO 9000 FAMILY?"

Presentation by George Hummel

Founder, IQC LLC

Slated for publication in 2013, potential revisions in ISO 9001 are being discussed, as well as the future of ISO 9004 and the Quality Management Principles. The US TAG will meet twice in 2012 to continue these discussions. George will provide an overview of the topics being discussed. He will also discuss the impact of ISO 17021 on the certification community. Whether your organization is ISO registered or getting ready to, don't miss these updates!

George Hummel is founder, IQC, llc. A management systems training and consulting company with over 1500 clients worldwide. He is an advisor to Automotive Supplier Quality Task Force (SQTF, predecessor to the IATF and IAOb) for QS-9000 3rd edition roll-out. George is a developer for the auditor certification process, the auditor tests and supervised the pilot program for QS-9000 3rd edition and the TE Supplement. He has been involved with the development of the AIAG Core Tools Training (*APQP, APQ, PPAP, PFMEA, MSA, R&M & SPC*) for the ISO/TS Auditor certification process, as well as the basic courses for each standard. George is a member of the AIAG's Task Force for ISO/TS 16949:2002 transition, Member of the AIAG *Truck & Heavy Equipment Reliability Task Force*, Co-Developer of the AIAG ISO/TS 16949:2002 transition guideline. Presently, George is the Managing Partner of Global Certification-USA, A Lead Assessor for: ISO 9001, ISO 13485, ISO 14001, ISO 17025, OHSAS 18001, GMA-SAFE (Food safety). He is an elected member of the US Technical Advisory Group (TAG) to ISO Technical Committee (TC) 176 (ISO/TC 176) the committee responsible for drafting the ISO 9000 series of standards and guidelines. George is also a member of the Dayton Area Chamber of Commerce Board of Trustees, formerly Vice-Mayor of the City of Trotword, and President of the Vandalia Butler Board of Education.
